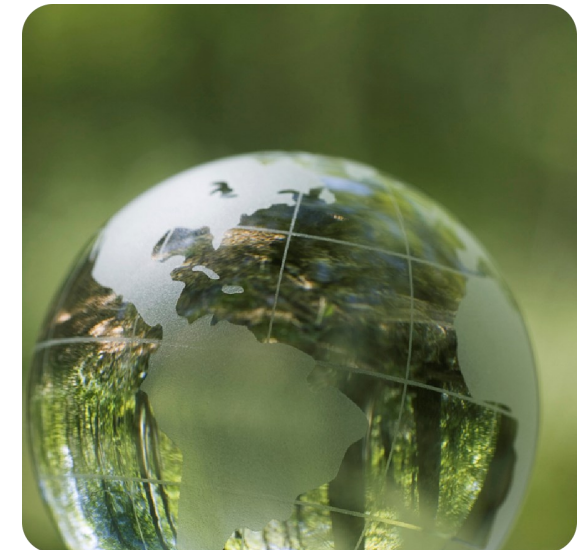

**Do you have a son, daughter or grandchild who will be attending university, college or technical school in the upcoming school year?**

## **HISTORY**

Each year, scholarships are awarded to children or grandchildren of Jay's employees who will be attending university, community college, or technical school on a full-time basis.

These scholarships will assist with the costs of post-secondary education. It's Jay's way of investing in our future.

## **WHAT IS THE ANNUAL DEADLINE?**

The scholarship application must be submitted **no later than midnight, June 30th**. Official transcripts of courses and grades must be received by July 31st.

## **HOW CAN FUNDS BE USED?**

Scholarships are for tuition and are paid directly to the post-secondary institution.

## **WHO CAN APPLY?**

Students who have been accepted for, or applied for, entrance to a provincially recognized university, community college or technical school, as well as students who are already attending post-secondary training. Mature students are also welcome to apply.

Scholarship recipients from previous years may re-apply and more than one eligible family member may also apply. However, first-time applicants will be given preference.

The order of categories for consideration:

1. First-time applicants.
2. Applicants with family members who received scholarship previously.
3. Applicants who have received the scholarship in previous years.

## **SELECTION PROCESS**

The Scholarship Selection Committee rates the applicants using the following rating scale:

- 40% Academic/Marks
- 20% Financial Need (self-supporting student)
- 20% Years of Service of Jay's Employee
- 10% Extracurricular Activities
- 10% Essay/Character

The applicant must show need, scholastic achievement, maintain full-time student status and be an individual of good character and integrity. Scholarships will be awarded without regard to sex, race, colour, or nationality.
